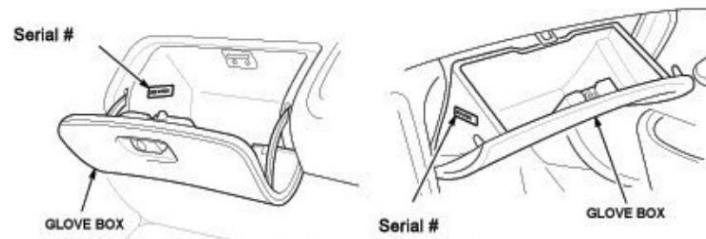


Finding Your Radio Security Code

Your car may be equipped with a factory radio that will lose its security code if you disconnect the 12v battery for resetting the IMA system. This code will need to be entered into the radio each time you reset the 12v battery, otherwise the radio will refuse to work. The rest of the car is functional, this only affects the radio system. If the radio does not show “code” upon reset or you have an aftermarket radio, then the system does not need the code entered.

Simple method:

Hopefully, your code may be found on the left side of the glove box compartment. It could have the security code or the serial number. It may also be in the owner’s manual. If it’s the serial number, an 8 digit number, then skip to step 7 below. If it’s the security code, enter it into the radio.



Elaborate method:

1. Make sure the charger is unplugged from the car, turn on the car
2. Turn the radio off, you should only see the clock displayed
3. Press and hold preset button 1 and 6 simultaneously for 15 to 20 seconds
4. While still holding those buttons, press the power button
5. A “U” and a 4 digit number should be displayed: “Uxxxx”. Then it should toggle to: “Lyyyy”
6. Record those numbers. Your radio’s serial number is xxxxyyyy
7. Now go to <https://radio-navicode.honda.com/framepage.aspx?theme=Honda> and enter the information to retrieve the security code.



8. Record this security code so you have it next time
